

FUND OBJECTIVE

The Fund's objective is to seek long-term capital appreciation.

INVESTMENT STRATEGY

The Fund benefits from two overlapping investment strategies, allowing capital to be put to work simultaneously as:

- A core holding of 100% passive long exposure to the S&P 500 Index, allowing full capture of long-term equity appreciation.
- A quantitative overlay strategy that makes long and short investments in liquid futures and cash FX markets lasting from one hour to up to 10 days. The overlay strategy is designed to mitigate the Fund's downside risk, generate positive returns during volatile, directionless periods for equities, or from volatility in non-equity sectors such as interest rates, foreign exchange, and commodities, and achieve additional upside during bull markets.

INVESTMENT PHILOSOPHY

The Sub-Advisor's investment philosophy is inspired by Computational Neuroscience. It posits that markets are predictable in the short term due to powerful, innate cognitive and behavioral biases among participants—not just in their decision making but even embedded in the quantitative models they create.

The futures overlay automatically finds and executes investment opportunities using proprietary algorithms. Because of its active, short-term, bi-directional nature, the futures overlay is distinct from long-biased equity strategies, long-term trend-following, or volatility selling approaches.

It is designed to deliver diversifying, protective alpha, boosting performance while reducing equity risk.

UNIQUE ADVANTAGE

The Fund's competitive edge stems from a combination of neuroscience-inspired strategies, proprietary machine-learning technology and advanced infrastructure. Its foundation is an over-30-year track record and an experienced team of market experts and data scientists, working in an institutional firm focused on innovation, stability and safety.

The Rational/RGN Hedged Equity Fund seeks enhanced upside capture, reduced downside risk and additional profits from periods of high market volatility by combining 100% exposure to the S&P 500 Index with a dynamic multi-asset futures trading overlay.

Primary Goals & Reasons to Invest

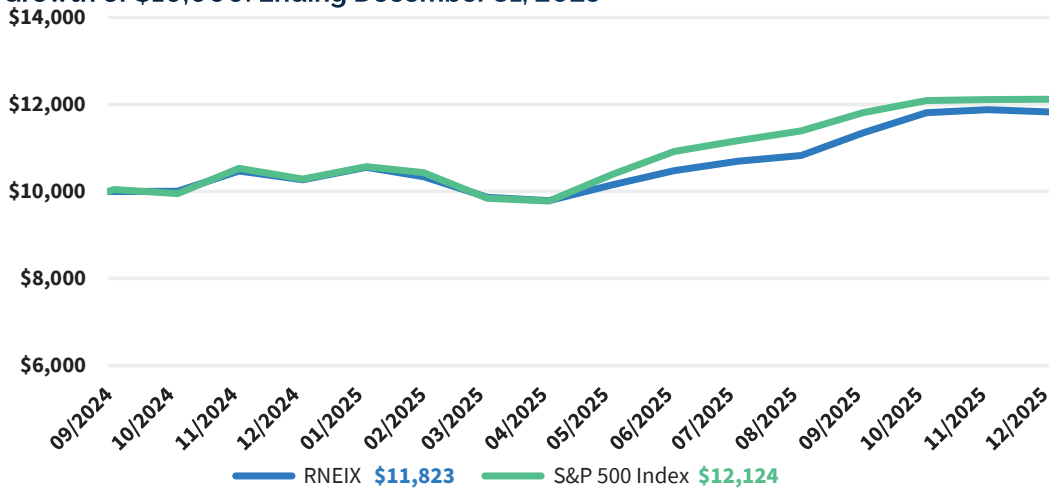
Enhanced S&P 500 Index: The Fund is an enhanced equity replacement that aims to provide additional returns in bull markets and periods of directionless volatility from dynamic long and short futures investments.

Reduced Downside Risk: The quantitative futures overlay is designed to be most effective during periods of high market volatility. Since volatility tends to rise during equity market declines, the overlay can potentially reduce losses during these periods.

Opportunities in Volatile Equity Markets and Other Sectors: The futures overlay invests in up to 60 liquid global equity, fixed income, commodity, and FX markets. Its focus on dynamic investment opportunities lasting less than 10 days can allow it to profit even if there is no overall stock market direction.

Benefits from Negative Correlation: The overlay strategy derives from a proprietary absolute return/downside protection approach implemented by the sub-advisor since 1993. The overlay is expected to be negatively correlated to equities, and aims to reduce the overall risk of the Fund to below that of the S&P 500 Index, while simultaneously improving its return.

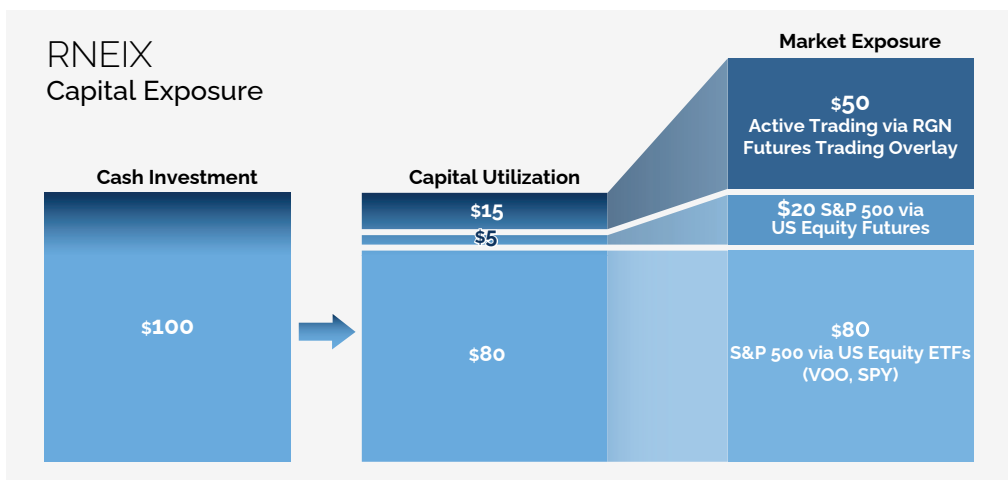

For illustrative purposes only. Capital utilization refers to the dollar amount of margin collateral that an investment uses to buy on the margin. Alpha: A measure of the difference between a fund's actual returns and its expected performance, given its level of risk as measured by beta. **Beta:** A measure of a fund's sensitivity to market movements. **S&P 500 Total Return Index:** is considered to be generally representative of the U.S. large capitalization stock market as a whole. **Standard Deviation:** a statistical measurement of the dispersion of a dataset relative to its mean. **Sharpe Ratio:** compares the return of an investment with its risk. **Sortino Ratio:** a variation of the Sharpe ratio that differentiates harmful volatility from total overall volatility by using the asset's standard deviation of negative portfolio returns instead of the total standard deviation of portfolio returns.
